Band's new MySpace site grows in number of visits, friends

Daily, more and more people are flocking to see the MySpace Web site created by A Flock of Seagulls leader Mike Score.

AFOS Lead Guitarist Joe Rodriguez has spent countless hours constructing the site, "going through design and color choices, ripping and uploading songs, setting up the discussion group and choosing the topics," he said.

The site was launched in mid-April. As of Wednesday, May 30, the number of profile views was 18,886. A total of 1,616 people are listed as the band's friends.

"This is an opportunity for fans to have an unprecedented amount of direct access with Mike and the current members of AFOS," he said. "While most internationally known bands' MySpaces are run by webmasters and moderators, our site is run exclusively by the band itself."

One of the most significant additions to the AFOS site since April is the group's discussion group. The new feature allows the band's friends to join and post comments on one of several topics listed by Score, who is the moderator.

Also since April, the MySpace site now features four of the band's songs: "I Ran," possibly other items such as T-

ting Sun" and "All I Wanna Do," quickly garnering favorable comments from the band's fans. AFOS friends may add any of the songs to their profile page. Combined, the four songs have generated more than 22,000 total plays.

In addition, photos of the band, including the newest members Michael Brahm and Pando, and some of their well-known been music videos have uploaded onto the site for fans to enjoy. AFOS friends also may use the music videos on their own MySpace pages.

The band currently is working on a feature that will allow its MySpace friends to purchase songs and

The AFOS MySpace site is not the only Web venue that has gained momentum in a short period of time. The number of visitors to the AFOS Fan Club Web site also has increased dramatically, 21,149 since January.
